


Adjustable Internal Damper Installation Guide


The adjustable internal damper allows you to restrict the draw in an over drawing flue. It is installed below the spigot. Do not install into a stove whilst it is hot or in use. Observe safe working practices whilst installing or adjusting. Please consult the stoves original Installation Guide for further information.





Step 1

Remove the throat plate and the three nuts holding the spigot in place. Ensure the spigot does not drop from its position whilst these nuts are removed.



Step 2

Place the damper assembly onto the three threads in the stove. The flat edge of the damper assembly should self-locate to the rear of the stove. Replace washers and nuts in the order illustrated below.



Step 3

The completed spigot and adjustable damper should look similar to below, but in situ in the stove.



Step 4

You can adjust the damper by loosening the two adjustment nuts, sliding the plate as required and then tightening.
